How to become a member of HTFCU:

- Forms are available in the main offices of each school—see your school liaison or our website.
- Fill out a new membership form and a payroll withholding form to authorize payroll deductions for savings. Two (2) forms of ID are required (e.g. school picture ID, passport, license).
- To open an account, send the enrollment form and the withholding form plus a check for \$25.00 as your first deposit to: HTFCU, P.O. Box 789, Harrison, NY 10528. (or you may use Inter-Office Mail on Mondays at your school location.)
- Check our website or Facebook page regarding loans, statement mailing dates, and general information. Forms for loans, withdrawals, etc. are available for printing.
- **Note:** First year employees are restricted to a loan of \$5,000, and all borrowers must be HTFCU members for sixty (60) days.

Why choose HTFCU for Financing?

- Share secured loans at 6% are available.
- Unsecured loans up to \$10,000 may not require a co-signer.
- Total indebtedness (loans and loans for which you have co-signed) cannot exceed \$50,000.
- Personal and Automobile loans may be granted for a period not to exceed five (5) years and up to a maximum amount of \$30,000 for the purchase of a vehicle.
- Our loan process is very convenient and loan payments are made through payroll deductions or for those members who are not presently employed by HCS D monthly payments are required.
- Education loans will be written for members, their spouses, and their dependents. Payment is sent directly to the educational institution. (Tuition bills are required to be eligible for this type of loan.)
- An applicant's credit worthiness is determined by Experian.
- Loan rates are set based on credit worthiness and type of loan.

Why choose HTFCU for savings?

- Save cash for summer, special events and holidays.
- Dividends paid by HTFCU will be reflected in statements.
- Savings are NCUA (Federal Regulatory Agency) guaranteed up to \$250,000.
- HTFCU is owned by shareholders for shareholders.
- You may deposit up to \$4,000 per month.

1. Loan applications can be obtained from our HTFCU website, your school liaison or at the HTFCU offices.
2. Fill out the form completely. Please note: All borrowers must have completed a 60-day period as a HTFCU member.
3. Attach two pay statements for each borrower and co-signer and any supplemental income documentation for the applicant and co-signer.
4. Send the application to:

5. After loan approval, the promissory note and ancillary papers will be returned to you for signature. After your proper completion of all paperwork, a check will be sent to you.
